Woodbury Conservation Corridor Prairie Restoration

Week 2: Saturday, October 2nd

Franconia Bluffs Acorn Planting
8:30am – 12:30pm

On this stop we will plant one million acorns collected by community youth groups throughout the metro to restore native oak woodlands!

Week 3: Saturday, October 9

Lost Valley Scientific and Natural Area Restoration
8:30am – 12:30pm

Our last stop is in Cottage Grove, where we will be clearing invasive species that are threatening prairie grasses and wildlife that are in danger of being lost!
